

WHERE TO SEND THIS FORM BCN has a Fraud Investigator in each of our four counties. There is also a Fraud Investigator at the central BCN office. The table below tells where to send this form based on where the services were provided and where the BCN Member lives.

In most cases, this will be the same as the county where the services were provided. | | |

If you're not sure where to send the form: Send it to the Fraud Investigator at the BCN office. It will be reviewed and routed to the appropriate county.

If you have reason to believe that the county cannot respond appropriately to this report, or if the suspected Fraud or Abuse involves the county: Send the form to the Fraud Investigator at the BCN office.

What is Fraud? An intentional deception or misrepresentation made by a person with the knowledge that the deception could result in some unauthorized benefit to him/herself or some other person.

What is Abuse? Provider practices that are inconsistent with sound fiscal, business, or medical practices and result in an unnecessary cost to BCN or OHP, or in reimbursement for services that are not medically necessary or that fail to meet professionally recognized standards for health care. It also includes OHP Member practices that result in unnecessary cost to BCN or OHP.
