The Peer Support services will be made available for any family in the community who is raising a child who experiences behavioral or mental health challenges. This new program will staff 2 full time employees, including Bi-Lingual/Bi-Cultural support. By offering assistance at the beginning of a family's journey, we encourage and empower parents and caregivers to find *their* voice and exercise *their* choice in navigating systems of care rather than being tied to a specific program to access Peer Support. This new form of support, offers multiple avenues to services such as: (family) self-referral and/or referral by community partners or providers. Families will also have the added benefit of Parent Support Groups.
